

PRESS STATEMENT

On the outcome of the meeting of the
Commission on Security Arrangements (COSA)
(Banda Aceh, 13.10. 2005)

The fourteenth meeting of the Commission on Security Arrangements (COSA) under the chairmanship of the Head of Aceh Monitoring Mission (AMM) Pieter Feith was held today Thursday 13 October 2005. Delegations from Government of Indonesia and GAM attended this meeting. The Gol mission was headed by Gen. Bambang Darmono. The GAM delegation was led by Mr. Irwandi Yusuf. All parties showed a strong commitment to the spirit of the Helsinki Memorandum of Understanding.

During this meeting the following topics were discussed:

- **Shooting Incident in Jeurun, Nagan Raya.**

A shooting incident in Jeuren, Nagan Raya was discussed and all parties agreed to fully cooperate in this issue. The parties are still in the process of collecting information and have decided to first establish the facts before processing this issue further.

- **Second Phase Decommissioning & Redeployment Plan.**

Decommissioning phase II: Final dispositions were agreed upon in what regards sites, safety corridors, and witnessing. Decommissioning of GAM armaments will take place in Aceh Utara on 14 October, Aceh Timur on 15 October and in Aceh Tamiang on 17 October, all in total transparency.

Redeployment of troops as part of phase II: Police redeployment will take place on 14 October and the total number of BRIMOB to be relocated will be 1050. TNI redeployment will take place on 18, 20 and 24 October. The total number of non organic TNI to be relocated will be 6119.

Next meeting to take place on Saturday 15 October 2005 at 10 o'clock.
